Big hearted RAF man, Lee Yarnell, is running the Maratona Di Roma (Rome Marathon) to aid a charity that helps his young god-daughters, Sophia May and Isla Tennison, whose lives are affected by debilitating blackouts..

After visiting many paediatricians to find the cause for their daughters' blackouts, Sophia-May and Isla were finally diagnosed last year with Reflex Anoxic Seizures (RAS). Syncope Trust And Reflex anoxic Seizures (STARS), The Blackouts Trust, the leading charity for support and information on syncope and reflex anoxic seizures provided help and training to the girls' schools and their ballet class. STARS' support has enabled the girls to participate in all activities and enjoy a normal life.
